## SINGLE USE ITEMS

All Plastics #1-7 and un-numbered items

- Soft Plastics - Plastics bags, bread bags, candy wrappers, snack bags, bubble wrap, juice pouches, pet food/treat bags, trading card wrappers etc.
- Hard Plastics- pill bottles, takeout containers, bottle caps, bread tags etc.

Styrofoam

- Expanded Polystyrene
- Expanded polyethylene
- Packing peanuts

Redeemable Cans/Bottles

Empty Cardboard Shoe Boxes

## UNIVERSAL WASTE

All Electronics

- Computers, mouse, keyboards, USB drives, CDs, DVDs, phones, tablets, game consoles, wires, cables

All Lightbulbs **NO BROKEN BULBS**

All Batteries - Ends must be taped

- Alkaline, Lithium, Ni-Cad, Lead Acid & Zinc Carbon

## ITEMS WE DO NOT ACCEPT

Any food soiled or wet/moldy material  
Broken glass  
Bulging/leaking batteries  
Aerosols  
Any medication  
Razors  
Disposable masks  
Hazardous Waste

## GENERAL REMINDERS

- Items are accepted in almost **any condition**, condition determines whether or not they will be reused/donated/recycled
- All items must be **clean, dry** and **free of contaminants** such as food waste or dirt.
- Please make sure to clear electronics of personal/sensitive information prior to recycling
